Where can I be married at Maramec Spring Park?

A. Weddings are not permitted around the head of the Spring. Weddings can be held anywhere that does not obstruct the walkways and roadways.

When can we get married?

A. You can be married anytime of the year except during Old Iron Works Day's and Kid's Fishing Day. Although we do not reserve areas for weddings we do keep a schedule of upcoming weddings. Call ahead and we can tell you if a particular area is available.

What is the cost?

A. There is no cost to be married at Maramec Spring Park. All vehicles entering the Park will be charged the regular entry fee.

Does the Park provide chairs etc.?

A. We do not provide anything special for weddings.

Can we play wedding music?

A. Yes, but the volume must be kept low. Electricity in the Park is not available in most places. Small battery operated players are suggested.

Are signs permitted within the Park?

A. It is against park regulations to post any signs within the Park. This includes balloons etc. Nothing can be driven into trees, wooden structures or the ground.

Is there a place in the Park where we can change?

A. There is no place to change within the Park.

Which are the most popular areas to be wed?

A. The most popular areas are the Furnace, Waterfalls and the Point.

Can we drive to the wedding site to unload chairs etc.?

A. It depends where you choose to be wed. The Point Area is very accessible while the Furnace and Waterfalls are not. Automobiles are not allowed to use the service roads.
